

Goal 1: By June 2011, the number of final Grade 7 to 12 Math marks above 60 % will each increase by 8% from the 2006 - 07 baseline.

Strategy 1: We will create school-wide instructional alignments for all Math, Science, Social Studies, English, and Physical Education related courses Grades 7-12.

Strategy 2: We will increase the awareness of math curriculum outcomes by staff, students, and parents.

Strategy 3: We will meet by subject level to discuss and collaborate in the assessment of outcomes.

Strategy 4: We will document and analyze the math course recommendations for individual students and track their subsequent progress.

Strategy 5: We will provide workshops for all staff, which specifically addresses instructional practices.

Goal 2: By June 2011, 80% of students will respond “agree or strongly agree” to DOE survey questions related to teacher/student communication and fair treatment.

Strategy 1: We will establish a school wide theme focusing on fair treatment. Fair treatment consists of issues surrounding respect, personal interactions, personal safety, and diversity.

Strategy 2: We will develop methods which enhance positive interactions between staff and students.

Strategy 3: We will improve communication among the staff at MRHS.
